
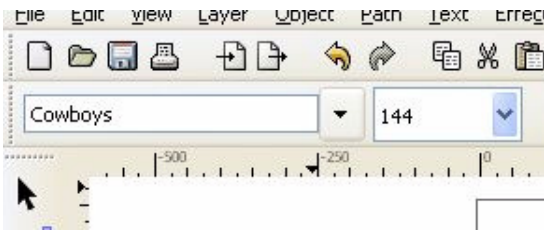


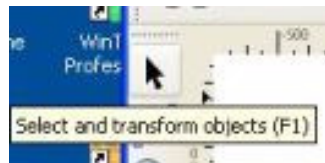
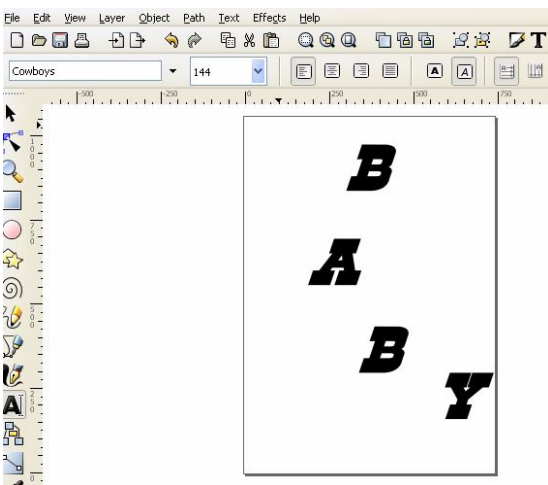
Connected Words in Inkscape

Step One: Type the word you want to type by typing an individual letter on a separate line by clicking on the text tool . By clicking on the text tool the font drop down box should display at the top of your screen. Select the font and the font size you would like to use. See screen print below:

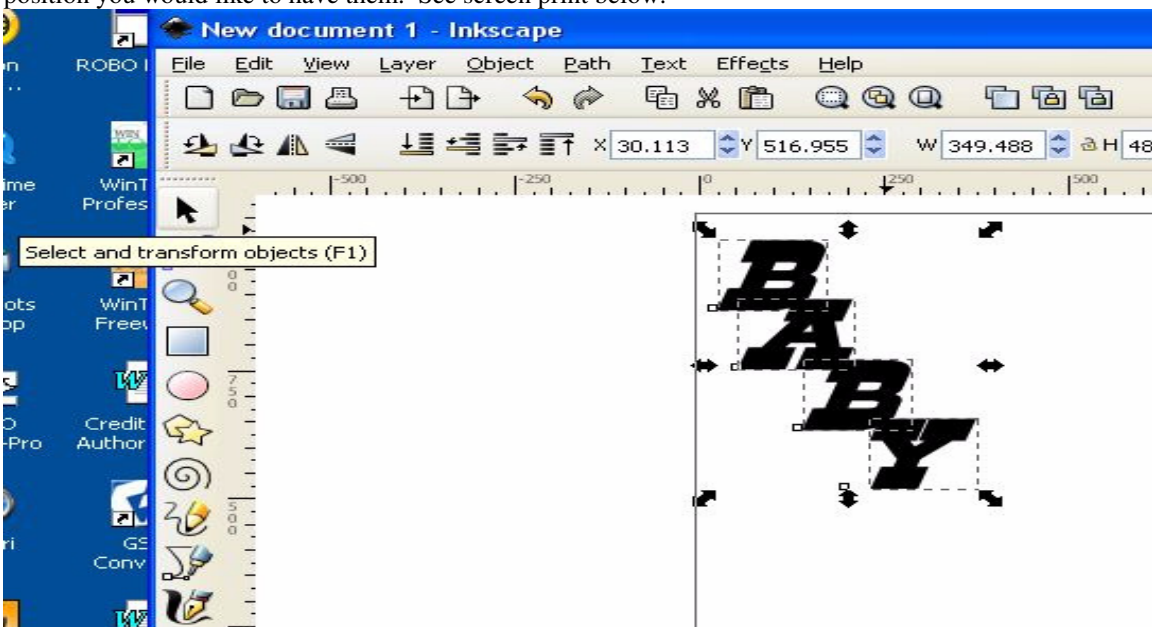


Once you have the font you would like to use, then just type a letter of the word, placing each letter on a separate line until you have letters for the entire word or phrase. See screen print below.

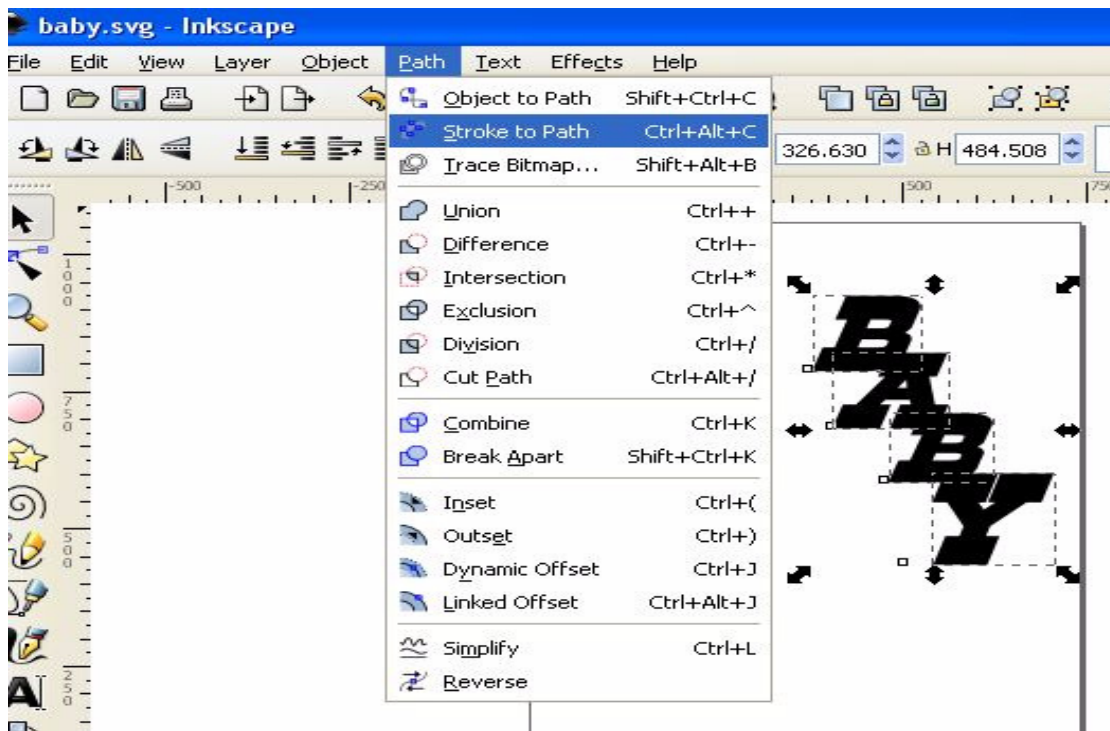


Step Two: Now click on the selector tool and then click and drag on the letters placing them into the position you would like to have them. See screen print below:

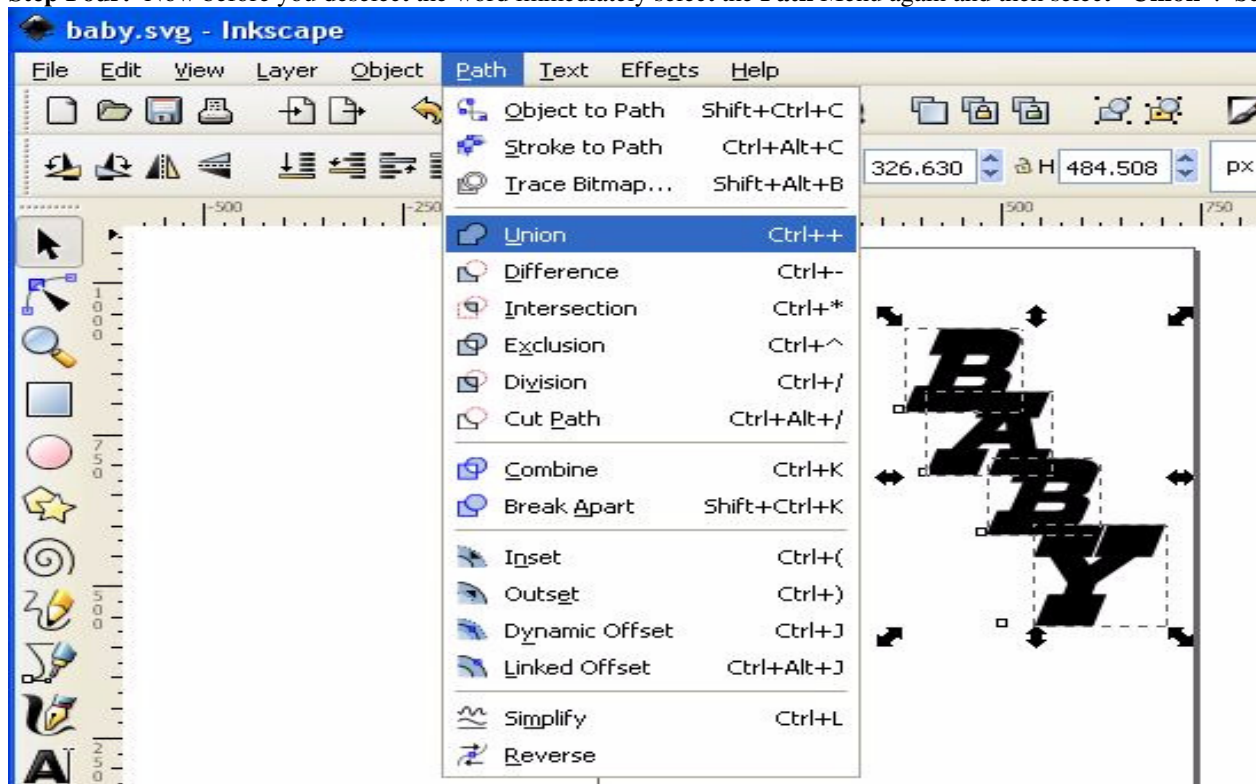
and then click and drag on the letters placing them into the



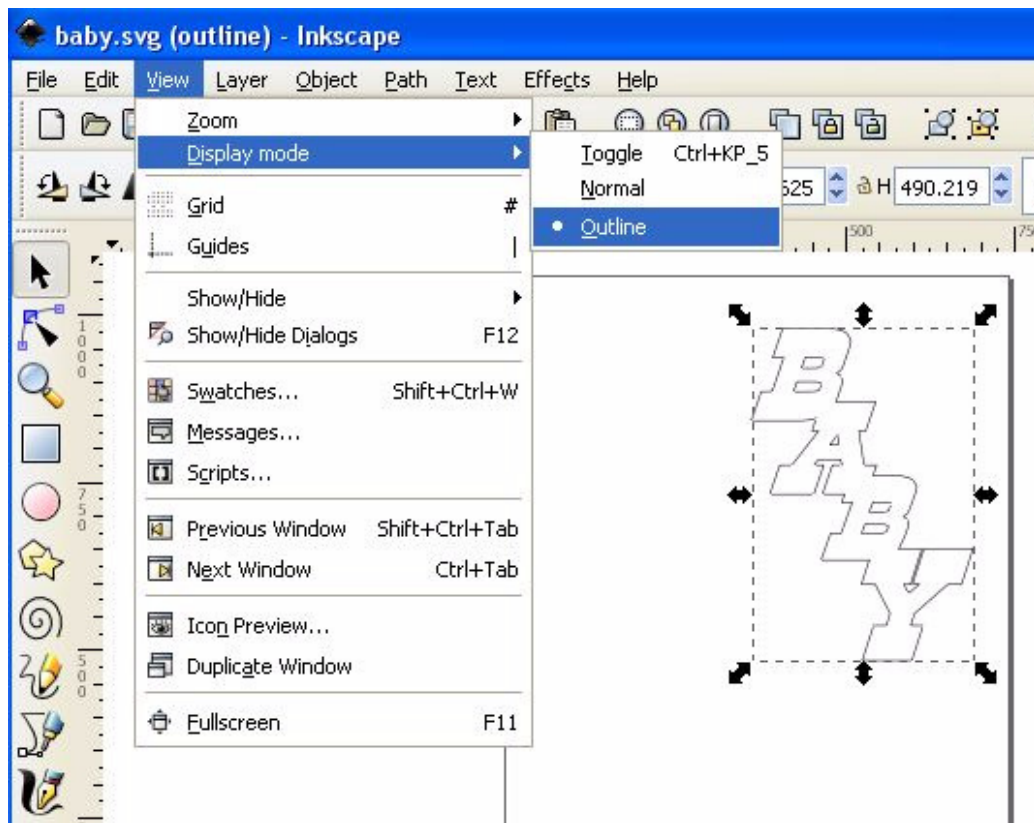
Step Three: Now with the selector tool already selected drag around the whole word selecting it and then click on the **PATH** menu and then select **“Stroke to Path”**. See screen shot below:



Step Four: Now before you deselect the word immediately select the **Path** Menu again and then select **“Union”**. See screen print below:



You now should have a connected word. You can see the word is connected by clicking on the **VIEW** menu and then selecting **DISPLAY MODE** and then select **outline**. See screen print below:



Now just click on the **FILE** menu and select **SAVE AS** and select **DXF**.

Now go into your robo master software and click on **FILE** menu and select **LOAD DXF**. You should now be able to cut out your connected word.
